

PRIVACY NOTICE

Your trust is very important to us. We are committed to protecting the privacy and security of your personal information.

It is important that you read this notice so that you are aware of how and why we are using such information. This privacy notice describes how we collect and use personal information about you during and after your relationship with us, in accordance with data protection law.

What will we collect and how will we use it?

If you are shortlisted following your application, we will request further information from you for security purposes including your address, passport number and driving licence number.

Retaining your personal information

Rolls-Royce will retain your personal information until Friday 2nd November 2018. If you are successful with your application, we will retain your personal information for two years.

Sharing your information

If your application is shortlisted, we will share the information that you provide to us (at that stage) with the Royal Air Force for security purposes. If you are successful, your name will be disclosed to the public.
